### 1. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A./B.Sc (Hons.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2018/2019/2020) are eligible to apply for Honours course in **1. Bengali, 2. English, 3. Sociology 4. Geology**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

## 2. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A./B.Sc (General.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Board/Councils are listed below) in the year 2018/2019/2020 are eligible to apply for General course with subjects 1. **Bengali**, 2. **English**, 3. **Sociology**, 4. **History (for B.A. Program)** and 1. **Anthropology**, 2. **Physics**, 3. **Mathematics**, 4. **Zoology**, (For B.Sc Program) provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

*Candidates passed the Vocational Course can apply in B.A. Program Course only*

## Merit Point Calculation:

### Merit Point = X+Y for Honours Course applicants

- X = 10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.
- Y= marks obtained in the applied subject as Hons, If that subject is not studied, consider the marks of one subject as indicated in the table:

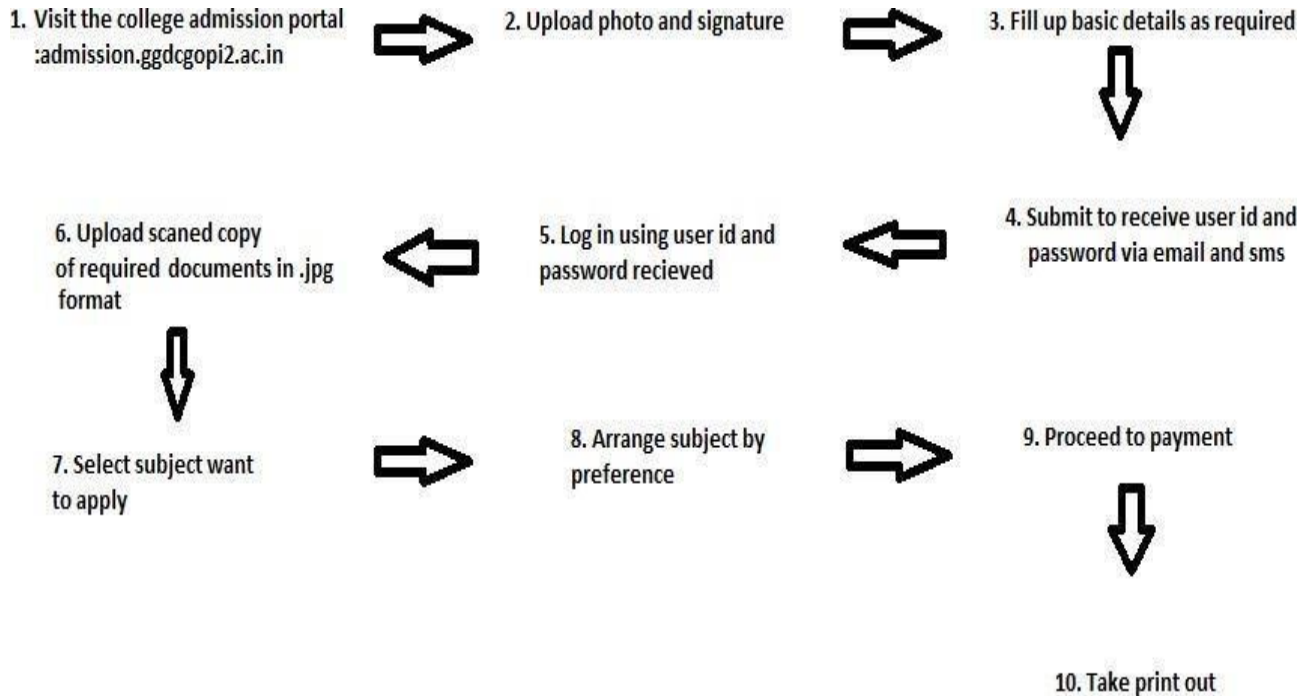

**Note:** If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same Y; preference will be given to higher marks in 1<sup>st</sup> Language.

### Merit Point = Z for Pass Course applicants

Z: for the applicants of the General Course, the merit point will be calculated counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.

### ***Please note:***

***Combination Subjects will be (GE and DSC) will be allotted as per availability following preference order provided by students. Subject change claims will be attended in special cases where 1st preference is not allotted and are subjected to availability. Therefore students are asked to fill arrange subjects according to right order of preference while filling up the application form.***

***In case of program courses, first subject will be treated as major subject and will be mentioned in graduation certificate. So please be careful while filling up the form.***
